Professor Emmy van Deurzen

Emmy is an existential therapist and honorary Professor at the University of Sheffield. Emmy has become a noted figure in the school of psychotherapy, being the first chair of the United Kingdom Council for Psychotherapy, and an ambassador for the European Association for Psychotherapy to both the European Commission and Council of Europe. Her work has been translated into a number of other languages, including Russian, Chinese and Spanish. In 1996 she founded The New School of Psychotherapy and Counselling at Schiller International University, where she is currently a Professor in Psychotherapy.

Professor Andrew Samuels

Andrew is Professor of Analytical Psychology at Essex University (UK), and holds visiting chairs at London, New York and Roehampton. Co-founder of Psychotherapists and Counsellors for Social Responsibility. Chair, United Kingdom Council for Psychotherapy. Jungian analyst in clinical practice and works internationally as a political consultant. Trained initially as an engineer, Colin went on to become a full time youth worker in London and then a teacher in Jamaica. He is a Fellow of BACP, an accredited counsellor and trainer and UKRC registered practitioner. Deeply committed to "transcultural concerns" he has had articles, videos and books published on the subject.
